

## Changes for MCS Coming!

There are big things in store regarding the future of MCS! As you are aware, MCS has been blessed by the Lord and continues to grow. As a result, MCS needs a larger facility. The Town of Milton is currently receiving proposals for the use of the former Bruce Street Library (45 Bruce Street). Principal Van Slingerland is preparing a proposal, together with input from an architect and the board, on how we would see using the property for MCS. The proposal is due on Nov 16 at 11 am. Following that, interviews will be held on Nov 22 and the decision will be made on Dec 5 at the Town Council meeting.

Recognizing that this is important to the future of MCS, **we would like to ask everyone to fast and pray.** Specifically:

- For protection, wisdom and favour for those involved with the proposal and interview processes.
- If it is meant to be, that MCS would be successful in the proposal.
- If the door is meant to close that the Lord would close it.

We believe this is a wonderful opportunity to express faith as a family and a community.
