- Drop off & Pick-up JK Grade 5 (Main Parking Lot)

- **Parents are not allowed in the building at drop off**. Teachers on duty will welcome children in the parking lot. Sign in your child(ren) if late to school.
- School dismissal 3:30pm. Kindergarteners are dismissed a few minutes earlier.
